The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of the DeWeese-Dye Ditch and Reservoir Company convened at the Golden Age Center at 5:00 p.m. with President Ron Dorn presiding. After it was determined that all the Board members had read the minutes, Dick Poyner moved to accept them as printed. Jeff Boccaccio seconded, and the motion passed.

The list of bills for February was furnished by the Secretary/Treasurer. After review by the Board, Dick Poyner moved to pay the bills. Jeff Boccaccio seconded, and all voted in favor.

On the matter of the proposed bridges for Grape Creek, Ron Dorn reported that the BLM is scheduled to have a meeting March 21, 2014. If all the BLM officials agree, permits for the bridges will be issued.

It was reported by Dick Poyner that Lake DeWeese is spilling. The snow depth at South Colony is 53 inches, which is average for this time of year.

The annual meeting of DARCA (Ditch and Reservoir Company Alliance) was attended recently by Dick Poyner. The focus of the meeting was on the flood damage sustained by northern areas of the State last year. Efforts to obtain resources for repairs are ongoing.

At 5:12 p.m. Dick Poyner made a motion to adjourn, Jeff Boccaccio seconded, and all agreed.
